

**Coaching Sessions - Guidelines for Parents/Carers**

The Committee of the club recognise the need to promote good practice within the Club for the safety and security of children, coaches, officials and volunteers. This is especially the case for the coaching sessions during which the coaches and volunteers have substantial contact with young people.

**The Club recognises its responsibilities and will ensure that:**

- Children are to be delivered to the venue by a responsible adult
- Once at the venue no child will be allowed out of the hall unsupervised
- No child will be released to an adult unknown to the supervisors
- At every coaching session, there will always be a minimum of two (2) club officials, coaches or volunteers who have current clear CRB disclosure checks present at all times
- All coaches and volunteers have read and retain a copy of the Child Protection Statement
- No club official, coach or volunteer will be left alone with a child or young person at any time
- In the event of a child needing to be taken home they will always be accompanied by two Club officials or volunteers
- All activities that take place will be appropriately planned for children and young people
- The Child Protection Policy statement will be available for anyone to read and will be posted on the Club's website [www.bncattc.co.uk](http://www.bncattc.co.uk)
- The English Table Tennis Association's Child Protection Policy and Guidelines are understood and adopted as good practice.
